On April 1st, 2021 the **Center for Research Data (CRD)** was established at the University Library of Southern Denmark.

**CRD** is strategically positioned at the library to coordinate activities with the rest of the university's service units which are the *analytics office*, the *research and innovation office*, the *IT department*, the *faculty research support units*, the *research ethical committee*, the *eScience center* and *SDU's data protection officer*.

The centre was a fusion of the two units already servicing the researchers at University of Southern Denmark: the **Research Analytics group** working with bibliometrics; and the self-explanatory **Research Data Management Support unit**.

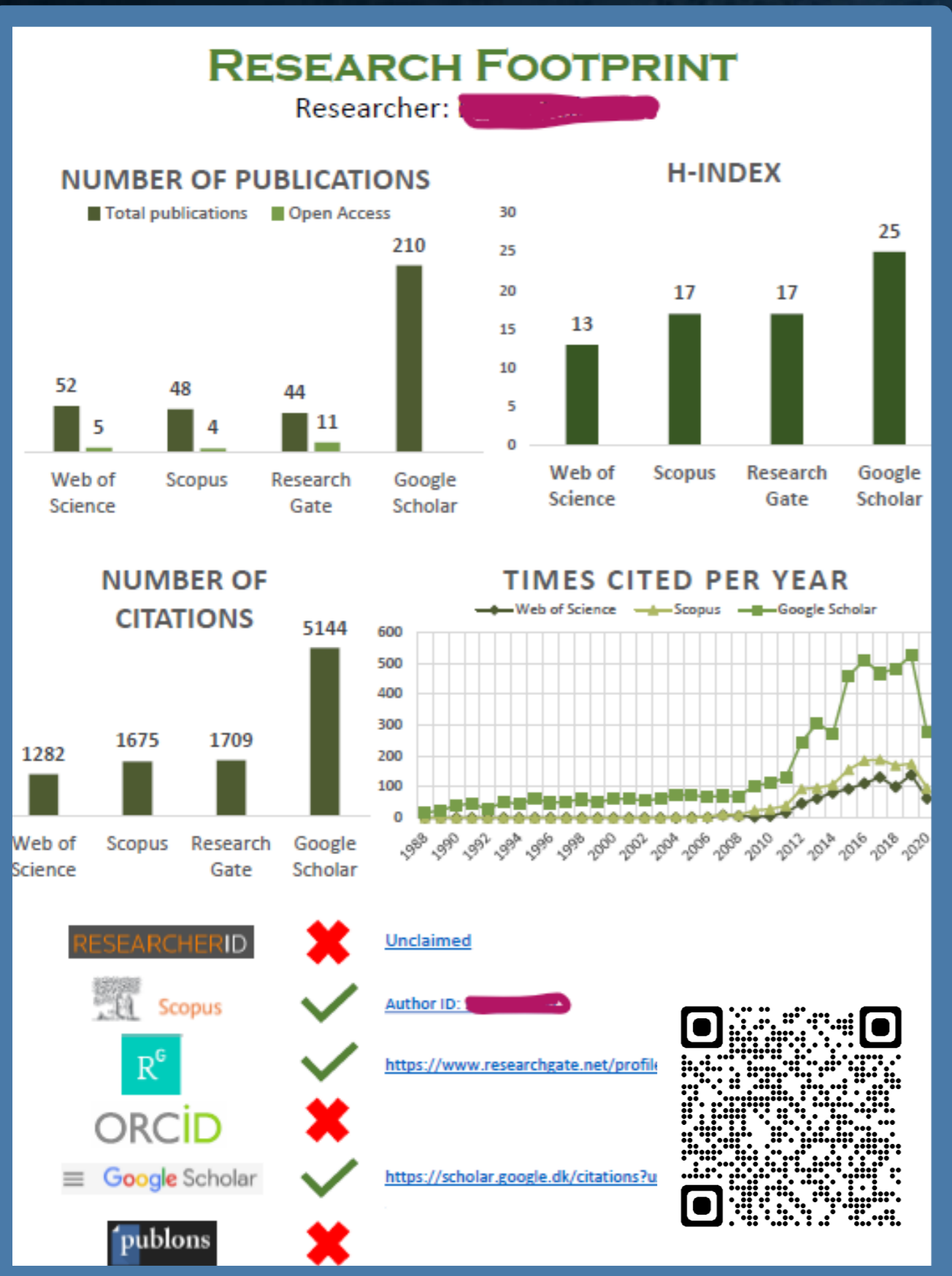


**RESEARCH ANALYTICS GROUP** does bibliometric and altmetric analyses for single researchers and research groups, and offers introductory courses to bib tools. This includes our *Research Footprint* that provides a visual overview of the online academic presence of a researcher by retrieving information from databases like Scopus, WoS, Google Scholar.



**RESEARCH DATA MANAGEMENT SUPPORT UNIT** offers hands-on help to researchers on handling their data from "birth" to when they will be deleted/anonymized or archived. We assist in:

- writing a *DMP* following the *FAIR principles*
- estimating RDM costs when applying for funding by following our customized *SDU RDM costing tool*
- writing better grant proposals with *Open Science (OS)*
- making *SDU policies on OS*
- national efforts on RDM including *infrastructure development*, creation of educational *e-learning videos*, a website on *How-to-FAIR* and a technical report on *Data Stewardship education*
