## Forskningsområde

Jeg interesserer mig for årsager til ulighed i adgang til sundhedsvæsenet såvel som ulighed i sundhedsadfærd og sundhed. Mit fokus er at forstå borgeres, patienters og sundhedsprofessionelles adfærd og præferencer. Herunder at forstå hvordan sundhedsprofessionelle prioriterer deres aktiviteter, når de arbejder under øgede ressource begrænsninger, samt når de står overfor diverse incitamentstrukturer.

Jeg anvender en række forskellige metoder i min forskning. Jeg har mange års erfaring med at designe spørgeskemaer og anvende præferenceafdækningsmetoder. Jeg anvender også laboratorie eksperimenter. En særlig prioritet er koblingen af register data med spørgeskema data om borgeres, patienters og sundhedsprofessionelles præferencer og motivationer, for dermed at skabe et unikt og rigt datasæt, der kan give større indsigt i adfærdsmekanismer og dermed

basis for en mere optimal organisering af sundhedsvæsenet.
