

My teaching is guided by the strong belief that the meaning of matter is generated in an interaction between lecturer and students. As a researcher it is my obligation to realize that my approach to a specific matter may be guided by a different meaning than the one guiding the students. I furthermore need to consider that a specific meaning does not necessarily go hand in hand with a specific matter. A specific meaning is the result of the lecturer's and the students' joint meeting with the matter. This process requires both well-prepared lecturers and well-prepared students. In the end, the exam situation is ideally the situation in which a student is confirmed in being able to link matter and meaning in a way that is experienced as helpful and as necessary for his or her professional development.
