I am inspired by Tine Bering Keiding's didactic triangle.

In the relationship between the teacher and subject, I strive for the subject matter to be research-based and preferably with the use of different research methods and visualizing different angles and areas of conflict.

In the relationship between subject and student, I strive to engage the student in activities such as workshops, projects, e-learning, and oral presentations. Naturally, all tasks are adapted to the student's knowledge, yet also developing them.

In the relationship between the teacher and the student, I strive to use self-assessment, peer-review and feedback, the latter in terms of feedback, feed up, and feed-forward.

Supervision

In a supervision process, I find the use of guidance, coaching, and instruction important to support the student's development. A development that needs to be based on the education level and the student. To achieve this, I apply formative education using feedback including feed up and feed-forward. Concerning this, Karl Tomm's different types of questions/model is a relevant tool, as it supports the involvement of the students and the learning objectives.

The different questions/model also helps to structure each supervision just as the model gives the feedback on the guidance.
