My mission is to contribute knowledge on Rehabilitation and Illness Mastery and design various research-based, interdisciplinary rehabilitation models that support people with illness in promoting health and well-being in daily living. A driver for me is to develop the concept of rehabilitation further. I find that the original idea of rehabilitation (from the 1930'es) to bring back honor in wounded, damaged, and disabled people's lives hold a crucial ethical claim. I believe this ethics can increase with future refined rehabilitation and a renewed focus on raised dignity in peoples' lives with disease and disabilities. Therefore, I work engagedly to produce knowledge on what is at stake to people challenged by illness and strive to incorporate a healthy lifestyle, especially physical activity, into daily routines. I respect this as transitions of which our understanding and thus support to the individual still is too limited.

I am an experienced qualitative researcher, especially in what is essential to people when managing everyday life with illness. I have extensive training in developing, testing, and evaluating complex (rehabilitation) interventions, including e-Health solutions. I am also trained in mixing research designs and analytical methods (qualitative and quantitative). Moreover, I intend to develop qualitative methods to guide future studies.

I have successful experience coaching professionals to refine interdisciplinary and cross-sectoral rehabilitation, focusing on what is essential to the patients. I thrive from creative interprofessional research collaboration. Moreover, I am an engaged educator interested in developing inspiring learning milieus. I am an excellent builder of research milieus and proud to be a central part of the research unit PROgrez, and the main driver for establishing a researcher's house at Næstved, Slagelse, and Ringsted Hospitals, which opened in late 2022.
