Teaching philosophy

From my perspective, the most important issue in teaching is to impart knowledge in a way that facilitates the learning of students. This necessitates a strong consistency between

- the form of teaching and the course type (lecture, seminar, student project, etc.)

- the form of teaching and the content (for example, in knowledge management courses, besides theory also methods for knowledge sharing should be taught, tested and reflected in group settings).

Taking the level of knowledge of the recipient into account is important to me in teaching. Therefore, I always make sure that the underlying theoretical concepts are in an understandable language that refers to previous lectures (of myself or other people), and that examples meet the experience of the class. For instance, I am using different examples and case studies for bachelor students and students in vocational training classes).

In any case, I am designing my classes and courses as a learning journey. I am including formats that stimulate interaction and reflection, that enable student engagement and active participation. For me, it is of uttermost importance to support students in linking the course content to their previous experiences.

The main topics I am teaching are Innovation and Knowledge Management and Megatrends.
