## **Current research activity**

I have three main research areas which are integrated within my current scientific activity:

1. Gynecological cancer
2. Robotic assisted laparoscopic surgery / minimally invasive surgery
3. Patient reported outcome measures

All three research areas are integrated in a highly profiled scientific collaboration between the Dept. of Obstetrics and Gynecology OUH and the Maersk McKinney Moeller Institute at SDU. The ROSOR (Research on Surgical Robotics) project was developed in 2012 and assigned as a Frontline Center at OUH in 2014. A total of 6 PhD students are affiliated and a steering group that besides me consists of Professor Ole Mogensen and Ass. Professor Thiusius Rajeeth Savarimuthu. The individual studies and the background for ROSOR are described shortly in the section on supervision.

In close collaboration with Ass Professor Dorte Gilså Hansen, the National Research Center for Cancer rehabilitation and Research Unit of Southern Denmark and Professor Ole Mogensen, a randomized controlled trial on follow up after gynecological cancer was initiated in 2014 and a PhD study affiliated. As a further development in the Dept. of Gynecology OUH, a post doc position has been appointed and funded from The Region of Southern Denmark to initiate additional studies elaborating on developing, implementing and evaluating patient-centered individualized follow up programs. Funding has been obtained from the Danish Cancer Society and OUH competition Fundings

I have been an active member of the European Organization of Research and Treatment of Cancer (EORTC) Quality of life Group since 2002. Within this group I have been the Danish collaborator in projects related to the development and validation of quality of life questionnaires related to gynecological cancer. Since 2011 I have been appointed as the principal investigator in a multicenter international study developing and validating a quality of life questionnaire for vulva cancer patients. The study has reached phase 4 in the validation process.

In collaboration with the Center for Shared Decision Making Vejle, two PhD studies have been employed evaluating different aspects of post-treatment follow up after ovarian and breast cancer. A further post-graduate study on shared decision making related to BRCA testing has been initiated and is on-going.

In collaboration with Professor Niels Qvist SDU a study is being developed on complications related to extensive cytoreductive surgery in ovarian cancer.

I have been sub-investigator in the DESKTOP 3; a multicenter randomized controlled trial that compares the effect of cytoreductive surgery + chemotherapy versus chemotherapy alone for platinum sensitive recurrent ovarian cancer. I included 14 patients in the study and was among the top 10 inclusion centers in Europe.
