## Teaching Philosophy

My teaching philosophy is rooted in my experience that students are adults who are motivated to learn but also focused on the end game—the final exam of the individual course, mandatory requirements throughout the semester, coordination among several courses, and ultimately the job market that lures in the horizon. My teaching is designed to help students in this effort to move from A to B but also, and significantly, to help them engage issues and perspectives in their own right and for the purpose of advancing critical thought and insight.

The principle I go by is that students will be more successful at the university and later in the job market if they gain the “agency” of critical thinking—the ability to engage complex information and make sense of it. Thus, if my teaching is successful, students will become more curious and reflective.

In my teaching I therefore challenge students to read complex texts and to transform it into their own knowledge that they must communicate sometimes in short written formats (blogs, policy papers, newspaper op-eds), sometimes in larger essays (academic research papers), and sometimes in student presentations in class. I am particularly focused on conceptual analysis and students’ ability to give meaning to concrete and complex problems, as opposed to theory development. My teaching aims to help students navigate and influence society.
