

## **Pedagogical idea**

Teaching means for me to enable others to learn. Students will learn most and best when they are intrinsically motivated. My role as a teacher consists therefore in showing students why something is worth learning and support them in their own learning process. My ambition is to spark students' interest for what I want to teach; to provide them with the basics to initiate their own learning process; and to offer them guidance and make this process, which is arduous at times, easier for them.

I believe that things are interesting when they are useful. Students will want to learn about accounting when they understand how it helps firms make better decisions. Real-life examples can give us an intuition of how accounting can make firms either succeed or fail. However, I believe that experiential learning is more sustainable than vicarious learning, and cases show us better than examples that our first intuition is often deceptive and how number crunching enables better decisions.

Whether I teach accounting or experimental methods, I want students to experience the benefits of learning immediately. Hence, I always strive to keep the lecture parts of courses to the necessary minimum and encourage rather action, interaction, and discussion among and with participants to involve them in the course.
